Modern results lists Peer review indicators are immediately displayed. Patrons can click to open the full text of an article in PDF or HTML, or download items for offline viewing and select the format such as PDF, HTML, or download the record metadata in CSV.

New PDF viewer and e-book experience EDS has a new PDF viewer, with which patrons can cite, share and add to a project, just like in the results list. Within this viewer, patrons can see how many copies are available to the library, and whether the title is currently in use. In addition to the new PDF viewer, there's a new e-book viewer, which gives the option of downloading the whole e-book, or selecting individual chapters from the table of contents.

Greater citing, sharing, and liking options Patrons can cite, like, add to project, share and download items directly from the results list. They can choose the format for their citations and have the options to copy them, email them and export them to tools like Zotero or NoodleTools. Enhanced *Publication Finder* For customers with *Full Text Finder, Publication Finder* offers browsing by alphabet, database and hierarchical subject, including specification of subject schema (general, medical or LoC) for subject browsing. A fast, responsive, single page application automatically refreshes as search options are selected. The targeted search type options include: "any," "contains," "proximity," "exact phrase" and "exact match." Configurable pre-search filters are based on resource type. There are also post-search facets for peer-reviewed, subject, database and resource type.



New mobile experience With the EBSCO Mobile app, patrons' research can be quickly accessed, accomplished and saved, allowing progress to be made anywhere, any time. Patrons can search quickly and save articles for later reading or listening. They can discover new content based on previous activity, and take advantage of mobile device technology, such as biometric authentication and voice-to-text searching.
